<i>The proverbs of Solomon, the son of David, the king of Israel:</i>	<i>{These are} the wise sayings said by Solomon. {He was} David's son and Israel's king.</i>

Who was the author of these proverbs?

Solomon, the king of Israel, was the author of these proverbs.

Proverbs 1:3

ULT	UST
<i>to receive instruction of insight, righteousness and justice and integrity;</i>	<i>{These wise sayings are} for instructing someone about what is insightful, righteous, just, and honest.</i>

How do these proverbs teach people to live?

These proverbs teach people about what is insightful, righteous, just, and honest.

Proverbs 1:5

ULT	UST
<i>(may a wise one hear and increase learning, and an understanding one acquire guidance),</i>	<i>(Let wise people listen {to these wise sayings} and learn more. Indeed, {let these sayings} guide understanding people so that they know what to do.)</i>

What can the wise and understanding receive by listening to these proverbs?

Wise people can increase their learning, and understanding people can acquire guidance by listening to these proverbs.

Proverbs 1:7

ULT	UST
<i>The fear of Yahweh {is} the beginning of knowledge; fools despise wisdom and instruction.</i>	<i>In order to become knowledgeable, a person must begin by deeply respecting Yahweh. {But} foolish people detest what is wise or instructive.</i>

What is the beginning of knowledge?

The fear of Yahweh is the beginning of knowledge.

Proverbs 1:8

ULT	UST
<i>Hear, my son, the instruction of your father and do not forsake the law of your mother,</i>	<i>My child, listen carefully to what I, your father, am teaching you. Indeed, obey the rules that your mother has commanded.</i>

To whose instruction should a son listen?

A son should listen to instruction from his father and mother.

Proverbs 1:10

ULT	UST
<i>My son, if sinners entice you, do not consent.</i>	<i>My child, if sinful people tempt you {to sin with them}, refuse {to do so}.</i>

What should a son do if sinners try to entice him to sin?

A son should refuse to follow those who try to entice him to sin.

Proverbs 1:11-13

With what do those who are sinning plan to fill their houses?

Those who are sinning plan to fill their houses with what they steal from others.

Proverbs 1:15-16

What do those who are sinning hurry to do?

Those who are sinning hurry to do wicked things.

Proverbs 1:19

ULT	UST
<i>So {are} the paths of all who unjustly gain unjust gain; it takes the life of its owner.</i>	<i>That is what happens to anyone who gains wealth in an unjust manner. What they gained unjustly will kill them.</i>

What does unjust gain do to those who gain unjustly?

Unjust gain will kill those who gain unjustly.

Proverbs 1:20-21

Who calls out in the streets, open areas, and city gates?

Wisdom calls out in open areas where busy streets intersect and at the entrance of the city gates.

Proverbs 1:24-25

What did those who lacked wisdom do when Wisdom called out to them?

Those who lacked wisdom ignored what Wisdom said and refused to listen when Wisdom called out to them.

Proverbs 1:26

ULT	UST
<i>I too shall laugh at your calamity, I shall mock when your dread comes,</i>	<i>Therefore, as for me, I will laugh at you when disastrous things happen to you. Indeed, I will ridicule you when you are terrified.</i>

What will Wisdom do when calamity comes on those who lack wisdom?

Wisdom will laugh when calamity comes on those who lack wisdom.

Proverbs 1:28

ULT	UST
<i>Then they will call out to me, but I will not answer. They will diligently seek me, but they will not find me,</i>	<i>At that time, those foolish people will cry out to me {to help them}, but I will not reply {to them}. Indeed, they will desperately look for me, but they will not be able to find me.</i>

What will Wisdom do when those who lack wisdom call upon her?

Wisdom will not answer when those who lack wisdom call upon her.

Proverbs 1:31

ULT	UST
<i>And they will eat from the fruit of their way, and from their plans they will be satisfied.</i>	<i>Those foolish people will suffer rightly for what they have done. Indeed, they will suffer fully for what they have planned.</i>

With what will those who lack wisdom be filled?

Those who lack wisdom will suffer rightly for their plans and for what they have done.

Proverbs 1:33

ULT	UST
<i>But the one who listens to me will dwell securely and will be at ease from the dread of evil."</i>	<i>By contrast, people who listen attentively to what I say will live safely. They will not fear that something evil might happen to them."</i>

How will those live who listen to Wisdom?

Those who listen to Wisdom will live safely and not dread evil.

Proverbs 2

Proverbs 2:1

ULT	UST
<i>My son, if you receive my sayings, and my commandments you store up with you,</i>	<i>My child, accept what I say. Consider what I command {you} to be precious.</i>

What does the father want his son to store up as precious?

The father wants his son to consider his commandments to be precious.

Proverbs 2:3-4

How should the son seek and search for insight and understanding?

The son should seek insight and understanding as silver, and search for it as a hidden treasure.

Proverbs 2:4-5

If the son seeks and searches for understanding as silver, what will he find?

The son will find the knowledge of God.

Proverbs 2:6-7

What is Yahweh for those who walk in integrity?

Yahweh is a shield for those who walking with integrity.

Proverbs 2:9-10

When wisdom comes into the son's heart, what will he understand?

The son will understand righteousness, justice, and integrity.

Proverbs 2:11-12

From what will discretion and understanding rescue the son?

Discretion and understanding will rescue the son from the way of evil and from people who speak perversely.

Proverbs 2:13

ULT	UST
<i>the ones who forsake the paths of straightness to walk in the ways of darkness,</i>	<i>Those people refuse to behave righteously in order to behave wickedly.</i>

What do those who walk in the ways of darkness forsake?

Those who walk in the ways of darkness forsake the paths of straightness, they refuse to behave righteously.

Proverbs 2:16-17

What does the strange woman forsake and forget?

The strange woman forsakes the companion of her youth and forgets the covenant of her God.

Proverbs 2:18

ULT	UST
<i>For her house sinks down to death and her tracks, to the spirits of dead ones.</i>	<i>{Being discreet and insightful will rescue you} because {going to} such a woman's house will cause you to die. Indeed, going with her is the same as going to the place where the spirits of dead people are.</i>

To where do the immoral woman's tracks lead?

The immoral woman's tracks lead down to death.

Proverbs 2:20

ULT	UST
<i>So you shall walk in the way of the good ones and the paths of the righteous ones you shall keep.</i>	<i>Therefore, behave like a good person. Indeed, conduct yourself like a righteous person.</i>

In whose way should the son walk?

The son should walk, or behave like a righteous person.

Proverbs 2:21

ULT	UST
<i>For the upright will dwell {in} the land, and the blameless will remain in it,</i>	<i>This is important because {only} people who live uprightly will live in our land, Indeed, it is the people who do not act wickedly who will stay in this land for a long time.</i>

What will happen to those who live uprightly?

People who live uprightly will stay in this land for a long time.

Proverbs 2:22

ULT	UST
<i>but wicked ones will be cut off from the land, and treacherous ones will be torn away from it.</i>	<i>By contrast, Yahweh will remove people who act wickedly from our land. Be sure of this: Yahweh will completely remove people who act treacherously from this land!</i>

What will happen to those who are wicked?

Those who are wicked will be removed from the land.

Proverbs 3

Proverbs 3:1-2

What will the father's commands and teachings add to his son?

The father's commands and teachings will add years of life and peace to his son.

Proverbs 3:3

ULT	UST
<i>Do not let covenant faithfulness and trustworthiness leave you; tie them on your neck, write them on the tablet of your heart,</i>	<i>Always be faithful and trustworthy. Let everyone see {how faithful and trustworthy you are, as if} they were a necklace you are wearing. Remember to be faithful and trustworthy at all times.</i>

Where must covenant faithfulness and trustworthiness be written?

Covenant faithfulness and trustworthiness must be written on the tablet of one's heart.

Proverbs 3:5

ULT	UST
<i>Trust in Yahweh with all your heart and on your understanding do not lean.</i>	<i>Trust Yahweh completely, and do not rely on what you understand.</i>

On what must the son not lean?

The son must not lean on (rely on) his own understanding.

Proverbs 3:7

ULT	UST
<i>Do not be wise in your eyes; fear Yahweh and turn away from evil.</i>	<i>Do not think that you know what is best. Instead, revere Yahweh and refuse to do what is evil.</i>

How must the son not see himself?

The son must not see himself as wise.

Proverbs 3:9

ULT	UST
<i>Honor Yahweh from your wealth and from the first of all your produce,</i>	<i>Revere Yahweh {by giving to him} some of your riches, and {by giving to him} some of the first {crops} from everything that you harvest.</i>

What must the son do with his wealth?

The son must honor Yahweh with his wealth.

Proverbs 3:12

ULT	UST
<i>For whom Yahweh loves, he disciplines, and like a father, a son in whom he delights.</i>	<i>{Do not respond in that way} because Yahweh {only} reproves the people whom he loves, just as a father reproves the children whom he cherishes.</i>

Whom does Yahweh discipline?

Yahweh disciplines those whom he loves.

Proverbs 3:13-14

What benefits people more than having silver or gold?

Being wise benefits people more than silver could benefit them.
Indeed, being wise is worth more to people than having gold.

Proverbs 3:17

ULT	UST
<i>Her ways {are} ways of pleasantness, and all her paths {are} peace.</i>	<i>Being wise will allow you to live pleasantly. Indeed, in every way being wise will allow you to live peacefully.</i>

What are all the paths of wisdom?

All the paths of wisdom are peace.

Proverbs 3:19

ULT	UST
<i>Yahweh by wisdom founded the earth; he established the heavens by understanding.</i>	<i>Yahweh made the world through being wise. Through being skillful, he made the sky and everything in it.</i>

What did Yahweh do by being wise?

Yahweh made the world through being wise.

Proverbs 3:21-22

What will be life to the son's soul?

Prudence and discretion will be life to the son's soul.

Proverbs 3:24

ULT	UST
<i>If you lie down, you will not be in dread. You will lie down, and your sleep will be pleasant.</i>	<i>When you lie down {to sleep}, you will not fear anything. You will lie down {to sleep} and sleep peacefully.</i>

If the son walks in wisdom, what will happen when he lies down?

When he lies down, he will not fear anything, and he will sleep peacefully.

Proverbs 3:25

ULT	UST
<i>Do not be afraid of sudden dread and of the devastation of the wicked when it comes.</i>	<i>Do not worry about something terrible suddenly happening {to you}, or about {what will happen} when God destroys wicked people.</i>

Of what should the son not be afraid?

The son should not be afraid of sudden dread or devastation.

Proverbs 3:27

ULT	UST
<i>Do not withhold good from its owners, when it is in the power of your hand to act.</i>	<i>Do not refrain from giving what is good to people who deserve it when you are able to do so.</i>

What should the son do for those who deserve it?

The son should not withhold what is good from people who deserve it.

Proverbs 3:29

ULT	UST
<i>Do not plot evil against your neighbor, and he is dwelling securely with you.</i>	<i>Do not plan to harm people that you interact with, because they live near you and they trust you.</i>

What should the son not do to his neighbor?

The son should not make a plan to harm his neighbor.

Proverbs 3:32

ULT	UST
<i>For an abomination to Yahweh {is} he who goes astray, but with the upright ones {is} his secret counsel.</i>	<i>{Do not do so} because Yahweh detests {such} people who act wickedly, but he converses like a friend with people who act uprightly.</i>

Who does Yahweh detest?

Yahweh detests people who act wickedly.

Proverbs 3:34

ULT	UST
<i>Though to the mockers he himself mocks, yet to the humble ones he gives favor.</i>	<i>When people ridicule {others}, it is Yahweh who ridicules them, but he kindly helps those who are humble.</i>

What does Yahweh do to the mockers?

Yahweh himself mocks the mockers.

Proverbs 3:35

ULT	UST
<i>Wise ones will inherit honor, but stupid ones lift up dishonor.</i>	<i>People will honor wise people, but people will shame foolish people.</i>

What do the wise inherit?

The wise inherit honor.

Proverbs 4

Proverbs 4:1-2

What should the sons not forget?

The sons should not forget their father's instruction.

Proverbs 4:4

ULT	UST
<i>then he taught me and said to me, “Let your heart grasp my words; keep my commandments and live!</i>	<i>During that time, my father taught me. He told me, “Remember what I have told you! Do what I have commanded you, so that you will keep on living!</i>

How did the father tell the son he would live?

The father told the son he would live by keeping the father's commands.

Proverbs 4:6

ULT	UST
<i>Do not forsake her, and she will preserve you; love her, and she will guard you.</i>	<i>Keep doing what is wise, because doing so will keep you safe. Love doing what is wise, because being wise will protect you from harm.</i>

What will Wisdom do for the son if the son does not forsake her, but loves her?

Wisdom will watch over him and keep him safe.

Proverbs 4:8-9

What will Wisdom do for the son if the son cherishes and embraces her?

Wisdom will honor him, as if putting a crown of splendor on his head.

Proverbs 4:11

ULT	UST
<i>In the way of wisdom I taught you; I caused you to tread in the tracks of uprightness.</i>	<i>I instructed you in how to act wisely. I directed you in how to live in the right way.</i>

In what way did the father teach the son?

The father taught the son in the way of wisdom and directed him in how to live in the right way.

Proverbs 4:13

ULT	UST
<i>Grasp on to instruction, do not let go; guard it, for it {is} your life.</i>	<i>Consistently remember the things I have instructed you; keep remembering them! Always be mindful of them, because they will keep you alive.</i>

On to what must the son grasp, for it is his life?

The son must consistently remember the things his father has instructed him, for it is his life.

Proverbs 4:14-15

What path must the son avoid?

The son must avoid the path of the wicked ones.

Proverbs 4:16

ULT	UST
<i>For they do not sleep if they do not do evil and their sleep is robbed if they do not cause stumbling.</i>	<i>{Do not act wickedly} because {it is as if} evil people cannot even sleep unless they have done something evil {on that day}; {it is as if} they cannot rest unless they hurt someone.</i>

What do the wicked do before they can sleep?

The wicked feel that they must do evil before they can sleep.

Proverbs 4:18

ULT	UST
<i>But the path of the righteous ones {is} like the light of brightness, going and shining until the day {is} established.</i>	<i>As for righteous people, they will live {wisely and safely} as people do who walk in the sunshine; {they will live more and more wisely and safely,} just as the sun shines brighter and brighter until the brightest time of day.</i>

What is the path of the righteous like?

The path of the righteous is like the light of the sun that grows brighter until the brightest time of day.

Proverbs 4:19

ULT	UST
<i>The way of the wicked {is} like the darkness; they do not know on what they stumble.</i>	<i>{But} the way that wicked people live is {dangerous,} like people {who walk} in total darkness. {Like people walking in darkness do not know} what they trip over, wicked people do not know {what hurts them}.</i>

What is the way of the wicked like?

The way of the wicked is like the darkness.

Proverbs 4:23

ULT	UST
<i>Guard your heart more than all {that} is protected, for from it {are} the sources of life.</i>	<i>More than anything else, be extremely careful about what you think and desire, because those things will control how you live.</i>

Why must the son guard his heart extremely carefully?

The son must guard his heart extremely carefully, for from it are the sources of life.

Proverbs 4:24

ULT	UST
<i>Remove from you perversity of mouth, and the deviousness of lips put far away from you.</i>	<i>Do not say anything that deceives people. Indeed, never say anything that misleads people.</i>

What kind of speech and talk must the son put away?

The son must put away speech that deceives or misleads people.

Proverbs 4:25

ULT	UST
<i>Cause your eyes to gaze to the front, and cause your eyelids to be straight in front of you.</i>	<i>{Focus on doing what is right, like} someone who is always looking straight ahead. Indeed, {act like} someone who is looking straight in front of himself.</i>

Where must the son focus his gaze?

The son must focus his gaze on doing what is right.

Proverbs 5

Proverbs 5:1-2

What will the son learn if he listens carefully to what he should understand?

If he listens carefully to what he should understand, the son will learn to be able to choose wisely what to do, and to know the right things to say.

Proverbs 5:3-4

What will happen to you after being with an adulteress woman?

After being with such a woman you will be miserable, as if you had eaten a bitter plant.

Proverbs 5:5

ULT	UST
<i>Her feet are going down {to} death; her steps take hold of Sheol,</i>	<i>{Being with} such a woman will cause both of you to die. Indeed, what she does {with you} will cause you to become a dead person.</i>

To where are such a woman's feet going?

Her feet are going down to death.

Proverbs 5:7-8

What advice does the father give the sons about getting near any adulterous woman?

The sons are to keep far away from any adulterous woman and not even go near her house.

Proverbs 5:9

ULT	UST
<i>lest you give to others your splendor and your years to a cruel one,</i>	<i>If you go to such a woman, you will be giving the best efforts of your youth to others, and a merciless person will take away {everything that you would gain in} the best time of your life.</i>

What will the son give away if he goes to such a woman?

If he goes to such a woman, the son will give away the best efforts of his youth.

Proverbs 5:11

ULT	UST
<i>and you groan at your end, when your flesh and your body are finished.</i>	<i>Then you will groan when you are about to die and have worn out your whole body.</i>

What will happen at the end of his life if the son becomes involved with an adulterous woman?

If the son becomes involved with an adulterous woman, he will groan when he is about to die.

Proverbs 5:12

ULT	UST
<i>And you will say, "How I hated correction, and my heart despised rebuke!"</i>	<i>Then you will say, "I hated it extremely when people corrected me! Indeed, I scorned people when they rebuked me!"</i>

What will the son say at the end of his life if he becomes involved with an adulterous woman?

If he becomes involved with an adulterous woman, he will say that he hated correction and despised rebuke.

Proverbs 5:15

ULT	UST
<i>Drink water from your cistern and flowing waters from the midst of your well.</i>	<i>{So be like} someone who only drinks water from his own well; have sex with your wife only.</i>

From where should the sons drink?

The sons should only drink water from their own well, which means to have sex with his wife only.

Proverbs 5:18

ULT	UST
<i>May your fountain be blessed, and be glad because of the wife of your youth!</i>	<i>{As a result,} may Yahweh bless your marriage {with children}; enjoy {sexually} the woman whom you married when you were young!</i>

Whom should the son enjoy sexually?

The father tells the son to enjoy sexually the woman whom he married when he was young.

Proverbs 5:18-19

With what should the a son be exhilarated?

He should be exhilarated by how the wife of his youth loves him.

Proverbs 5:21

ULT	UST
<i>For in front of the eyes of Yahweh {are} the ways of a man, and all of his paths he observes.</i>	<i>{Never do that} because Yahweh fully knows what people do. Indeed, he knows everything that people do.</i>

What does Yahweh observe?

Yahweh knows everything that people do.

Proverbs 5:22

ULT	UST
<i>His iniquities capture him, the wicked one, and by the cords of his sin he is grasped.</i>	<i>The wicked things that wicked people do are {like} traps that catch them; the sinful things that they do are {like} ropes by which others can grab them.</i>

What will capture and grasp the wicked person?

The wicked things that the wicked one does will capture him and his sin will be like cords that grasp him.

Proverbs 6

Proverbs 6:1-2

How could the son be caught by what he says with his mouth?

The son could regret what he says if he guarantees a loan for a stranger.

Proverbs 6:3

ULT	UST
<i>then do this, my son, and rescue yourself: Since you have come into the palm of your neighbor, go, humble yourself, and press your neighbor.</i>	<i>then, my child, do this in order to save yourself {from having to pay back this loan}: humbly go to that person and beg him {to cancel what you have promised}, because he now controls you.</i>

What must the son do to save himself?

To save himself the son must humbly go to that person and beg him to cancel what the son has promised.

Proverbs 6:6

ULT	UST
<i>Go to the ant, lazy one! See its ways and be wise,</i>	<i>You lazy person, learn {something} from {watching} ants! Consider what ants do so that you can be wise.</i>

From what should a lazy person learn?

A lazy person should consider the ant, see its ways, and learn to be wise.

Proverbs 6:8

ULT	UST
<i>prepares its bread in the summer; it gathers its food in the harvest.</i>	<i>{Nevertheless,} they work hard all during the summer, gathering and storing food {to eat during the winter}.</i>

What does the ant do in the summer?

In the summer, the ant gathers and stores food to eat during the winter.

Proverbs 6:9,11

What will happen to the lazy person who does not rise from his sleep?

He will become poor and needy just as surely as if a thief has robbed him.

Proverbs 6:12

ULT	UST
<i>A man of worthlessness, a man of iniquity, {is} one who walks {with} perversity of mouth,</i>	<i>{I will describe for you what} worthless, sinful people {do. They} constantly deceive people by what they say.</i>

How would you describe worthless people?

Worthless, sinful people are people who constantly deceive other people by what they say.

Proverbs 6:14-15

What will happen to the wicked man because of his evil plots?

He will be suddenly destroyed and unable to recover.

Proverbs 6:16

ULT	UST
<i>Six {are} they {that} Yahweh hates, and seven {are} abominations to his self:</i>	<i>Yahweh absolutely hates six, no, seven things:</i>

How many things does Yahweh hate and how many things are abominations to him?

There are six things that Yahweh hates, seven that are abominations to him.

Proverbs 6:18

ULT	UST
<i>a heart devising plans of iniquity, feet hurrying to run to evil,</i>	<i>someone planning ways to act sinfully, someone eagerly looking for ways to act wickedly,</i>

What kind of heart does Yahweh hate?

Yahweh hates the heart of someone planning ways to act sinfully.

Proverbs 6:19

ULT	UST
<i>a witness of falsehood breathing out lies, and sending forth quarrels between brothers.</i>	<i>someone who naturally lies when testifying, and someone causing members of the same family to argue.</i>

What kind of witness does Yahweh hate?

Yahweh hates the witness who lies when testifying.

Proverbs 6:23

ULT	UST
<i>For commandment {is} a lamp and law {is} a light, and the rebukes of instruction {are} the way of life,</i>	<i>{This is so} because what I have commanded {you} is {like} a lamp {that shows you your way}. Indeed, the rules {we taught you} are {like} a light {to guide you}. When we rebuke you while instructing you, {we do that} so that you can do what will give you a good life.</i>

To what are commandment and law likened?

Commandment is likened to a lamp and the law is likened to a light.

Proverbs 6:26

ULT	UST
<i>For the price of a prostitute woman {is} as a loaf of bread, but the wife of a man hunts a precious life.</i>	<i>{Do not do so} because, although having sex with a prostitute may only cost you a cheap meal, {doing so with} an {adulterous} married woman will cause you to die.</i>

What can having sex with the wife of another cost the son?

Having sex with the wife of another will cause him to die.

Proverbs 6:30

ULT	UST
<i>They do not despise the thief if he steals to satisfy his appetite when he is hungry;</i>	<i>People do not resent someone who steals if he only steals {food} because he is hungry.</i>

Why might people not despise a thief if he steals?

People do not despise someone who steals if he only steals food because he is hungry.

Proverbs 6:32

ULT	UST
<i>One who commits adultery {with} a woman {is} lacking of heart; destroying his life, he does it.</i>	<i>By contrast, a man who acts adulterously with a woman is not thinking. By doing this, he destroys himself!</i>

Who does a man who commits adultery destroy?

A man who commits adultery with a woman destroys himself.

Proverbs 6:34-35

What will the one who takes revenge against adultery not accept?

That jealous husband will not accept any money to stop being furious, no matter how much money you offer him.

Proverbs 7

Proverbs 7:1-2

What must the son keep in order to live?

The son must keep his father's sayings and commandments to live.

Proverbs 7:4-5

From whom do Wisdom and Understanding keep the son?

Wisdom and Understanding keep the son from immoral women who speak to him seductively.

Proverbs 7:6-7

Who did Solomon notice as he looked out through the window?

Solomon noticed a young man who does not think wisely.

Proverbs 7:10

ULT	UST
<i>And behold, {there is} a woman to meet him, {with} the garment of a prostitute and guarded of heart.</i>	<i>Then I saw that an adulterous woman approached the young man. She was wearing a prostitute's clothing and intended to deceive {the young man}.</i>

What was the woman wearing who approached the young man?

She was wearing a prostitute's clothing.

Proverbs 7:12

ULT	UST
<i>At {one} time in the street, at {another} time in the open areas, and beside every corner she lies in wait.)</i>	<i>She {often} walked around the streets and public places. At the corner of any road she waited {for a man whom she could seduce}.)</i>

What does the woman do at every corner?

At the corner of any road, she waits for a man whom she can seduce.

Proverbs 7:14

ULT	UST
<i>"The sacrifices of peace offerings {are} with me; today I paid my vows.</i>	<i>"Today {I have meat in my house, because} I sacrificed an animal {in the temple} to promise friendship {with Yahweh}. {In this way} I did what I had vowed to do.</i>

What had the woman done that day?

That day, the woman had sacrificed an animal.

Proverbs 7:15

ULT	UST

What does not turn away from anything?

The lion does not turn away from anything.

<i>If you have been foolish by lifting up yourself, or if you have schemed, a hand {be} to mouth!</i>	<i>If you have acted foolishly by bragging about yourself, or if you were plotting {to do what is evil}, then stop doing so immediately!</i>

What should a person do who has been plotting evil?

A person who has been devising evil should stop doing so immediately.

Proverbs 30:33

ULT	UST
<i>For the squeezing of milk brings out butter, and the squeezing of the nose brings out blood, and the squeezing of nostrils brings out strife."</i>	<i>{Stop doing so} because just as churning milk produces butter, and squeezing a nose produces blood, making people angry causes them to fight.</i>

What does anger produce?

Anger causes people to fight.

<i>Do not give to women your strength or your ways to cause kings to be wiped out.</i>	<i>Do not exhaust yourself by having sex with women; they can destroy kings.</i>

To whom should a man not give his strength?

He should not give his strength to women and exhaust himself by having sex with them.

Proverbs 31:5

ULT	UST
<i>Lest he drink and forget what has been decreed and pervert the legal claim of all the sons of the afflicted one.</i>	<i>{They must not do this} so that they do not forget the laws {that they have made} and prevent all suffering people from getting what they legally deserve.</i>

What do rulers forget when they have strong drink?

Rulers forget what has been decreed when they have strong drink.

Proverbs 31:7

ULT	UST
<i>He will drink and forget his poverty, and his trouble he will not remember again.</i>	<i>They can drink {what can intoxicate them} to forget that they are poor and to completely forget what troubles them.</i>

What do those in bitter distress forget when they have strong drink?

Those in bitter distress forget what troubles them when they have strong drink.

Proverbs 31:9

ULT	UST
<i>Open your mouth, judge {with} righteousness, and plead the legal case of the afflicted one and poor one.</i>	<i>Defend, judge rightly, and plead for suffering and poor people to get what they legally deserve.</i>

Whose cause should the king plead?

The king should plead for suffering and poor people to get what they legally deserve.

Proverbs 31:10

ULT	UST
<i>A woman of worth, who can find? And her value {is} far more than coral pearls.</i>	<i>Virtuous and capable women are difficult to find! This kind of woman is more valuable than precious jewels.</i>

What is more valuable than jewels?

A virtuous and capable wife is more valuable than precious jewels.

Proverbs 31:12

ULT	UST
<i>She does to him good and not evil all the days of her life.</i>	<i>Such a woman benefits her husband for as long as she lives.</i>

What does the capable wife do all the days of her life?

She does good for her husband and not evil all the days of her life.

Proverbs 31:15

ULT	UST
<i>And she rises while still night and gives food to her house and a portion to her young women.</i>	<i>She gets up before dawn in order to prepare food for her family and to prepare some {food} for her female servants.</i>

When does the capable wife arise?

She arises while it is still night.

Proverbs 31:17

ULT	UST
<i>She girds her loins with strength, and she strengthens her arms.</i>	<i>She keeps her body strong, and she makes her arms strong {by working hard}.</i>

How does the capable wife care for her body?

She keeps her body strong and she makes her arms strong by working hard.

Proverbs 31:20

<i>She spreads out her palm to the afflicted one, and she stretches out her hands to the poor one.</i>	<i>She generously helps people who are poor and suffering.</i>

Whom does the capable wife generously help?

She generously helps people who are poor and suffering.

Proverbs 31:23

ULT	UST
<i>Her husband is known at the gates, when he sits with the elders of the land.</i>	<i>People respect such a woman's husband at the {city} gates, when he sits {there} with the {other} leaders of the city.</i>

Where does the capable wife's husband sit?

Her husband sits with the elders at the gates.

Proverbs 31:26

ULT	UST
<i>Her mouth opens with wisdom, and the law of covenant faithfulness {is} on her tongue.</i>	<i>She speaks wisely, and when she speaks, she teaches {others} to be faithful and kind.</i>

How does the capable wife speak?

She speaks wisely, and when she speaks, she teaches others to be faithful and kind.

Proverbs 31:28

ULT	UST
<i>Her sons rise up and call her blessed; her husband also praises her.</i>	<i>This woman's children stand respectfully and declare that she lives well. Her husband says good things about her, as well.</i>

What do the children of the capable wife call her?

Her children call her blessed.

Proverbs 31:30

ULT	UST
<i>The charm {is} falsehood and the beauty {is} vapor; a woman fearful of Yahweh, she herself will be praised.</i>	<i>Charming women {who are not good} can deceive people into thinking that they are good, and beautiful women will be beautiful for only a short time. However, people will {always} praise those women who reverently fear Yahweh.</i>

What kind of woman will be praised?

People will praise a woman who fears Yahweh.
