Mark 1

Mark 1:2-3

What did the prophet Isaiah predict would happen before the Lord came?

Isaiah predicted that God would send a messenger, a voice of someone calling out in the wilderness, to prepare the way of the Lord.

Mark 1:4

ULT	UST
<i>John came, the one baptizing in the wilderness and preaching a baptism of repentance for forgiveness of sins.</i>	<i>Now there was a man whose name was John. He baptized people in a desolate area. He proclaimed that people should allow him to baptize them. That would show that they were going to stop doing what was wrong. That way, God would forgive their sins.</i>

What did John come preaching?

John came preaching a baptism of repentance for the forgiveness of sins.

Mark 1:5

ULT	UST
<i>And all the Judea region and all the Jerusalemites were going out to him and were being baptized by him in the Jordan River, confessing their sins.</i>	<i>Many people who lived in the region of Judea and many people who lived in the city of Jerusalem often went to listen to John. Many of these people agreed that they had sinned. Then, John baptized them in the Jordan River.</i>

What did the people do as they were baptized by John?

The people confessed their sins as they were baptized by John.

Mark 1:6

ULT	UST
<i>And John was clothed with camel hair and a leather belt around his waist, and {he was} eating locusts and wild honey.</i>	<i>John wore rough clothes that he made out of camel's hair. He fastened around his waist a belt that he made from animal skin. He ate grasshoppers and honey that he found in that desolate area.</i>

What did John eat?

John ate locusts and wild honey.

Mark 1:8

ULT	UST
<i>I baptized you with water, but he will baptize you with the Holy Spirit."</i>	<i>I use water to baptize you. However, he will give you the Holy Spirit, which will be like baptizing you."</i>

With what did John say the one coming after him would baptize?

John said the one coming after him would baptize with the Holy Spirit.

Mark 1:10

ULT	UST
<i>And immediately, coming up out of the water, he saw the heavens being split open and the Spirit coming down on him like a dove.</i>	<i>As soon as John baptized him, Jesus waded out of the Jordan River. Then, he saw God opening the way from heaven. He saw that the Holy Spirit, who looked like a small bird, was descending {from heaven} to him.</i>

What did Jesus see as he came up out of the water after being baptized by John?

After being baptized, Jesus saw the heavens split open and the Spirit descend on him as a dove.

Mark 1:11

ULT	UST
<i>And a voice came out of the heavens, "You are my beloved Son. With you, I am well pleased."</i>	<i>Then God spoke from heaven, "You are my Son, the one whom I love dearly. What you do pleases me."</i>

What did the voice from heaven say after Jesus was baptized?

The voice from heaven said, "You are my beloved Son; I am very pleased with you."

Mark 1:12

ULT	UST
<i>And immediately, the Spirit casts him out into the wilderness.</i>	<i>As soon as that happened, the Holy Spirit sent Jesus into a desolate area.</i>

Who drove Jesus out into the wilderness?

The Spirit drove Jesus out into the wilderness.

Mark 1:13

ULT	UST
<i>And he was in the wilderness 40 days, being tempted by Satan. And he was with the wild animals, and the angels were serving him.</i>	<i>Jesus stayed for 40 days in that desolate area with the animals that lived there. During that time, Satan tried to make Jesus sin. Also, angels took care of Jesus.</i>

How long was Jesus in the wilderness, and what happened to him there?

Jesus was in the wilderness 40 days, and he was tempted by Satan there.

Mark 1:15

ULT	UST
<i>and saying, "The time has been fulfilled, and the kingdom of God has come near. Repent and believe in the gospel."</i>	<i>He declared, "This is the moment when God is about to establish his kingdom here. Stop doing what is wrong! Trust the good news!"</i>

What message did Jesus preach?

Jesus preached that the kingdom of God was near, and that people must repent and believe in the gospel.

Mark 1:16

ULT	UST
<i>And passing beside the Sea of Galilee, he saw Simon and Andrew, the brother of Simon, net-casting into the sea, for they were fishermen.</i>	<i>One day, Jesus was walking next to the Sea of Galilee. He saw {a man whose name was} Simon and that man's {younger} brother, {whose name was} Andrew. They earned money by catching and selling fish. {When Jesus saw them,} they were using nets to try to catch fish.</i>

What was the occupation of Simon and Andrew?

Simon and Andrew were fishermen.

Mark 1:17

ULT	UST
<i>And Jesus said to them, "Come after me, and I will make you to become fishers of men."</i>	<i>Jesus told them, "Come with me and be my apprentices. I will teach you how to gather people {to be my apprentices}, just as you have been gathering fish."</i>

What did Jesus say he would make Simon and Andrew become?

Jesus said he would make Simon and Andrew fishers of men.

Mark 1:19

ULT	UST
<i>And having gone on a little farther, he saw James, the {son} of Zebedee, and John, his brother, and they {were} mending the nets in the boat.</i>	<i>Then Jesus walked a short distance {next to the sea}. He saw {a man whose name was} James and that man's {younger} brother, {whose name was} John. They were sons of {a man whose name was} Zebedee. {When Jesus saw them,} they were preparing their fishing tools in a boat.</i>

What was the occupation of James and John?

James and John were fishermen.

Mark 1:22

ULT	UST
<i>And they were astonished at his teaching, for he was teaching them as having authority and not as the scribes.</i>	<i>The way that Jesus taught impressed {the people who were there}. {It impressed them} because Jesus did not teach as the teachers of the Jewish law did. Rather, he taught them like someone whom God had authorized to do so.</i>

Why did Jesus' teaching astonish the people in the synagogue?

Jesus' teaching astonished the people because Jesus taught as one with authority.

Mark 1:24

ULT	UST
<i>saying, “What to us and to you, Jesus of Nazareth? Have you come to destroy us? I know who you are—the Holy One of God!”</i>	<i>“Jesus from the town of Nazareth, leave us alone! You must be here to punish us. I realize who you are. You are the special one whom God has set apart!”</i>

What title did the unclean spirit in the synagogue give Jesus?

The unclean spirit in the synagogue gave Jesus the title of the Holy One of God.

Mark 1:28

ULT	UST
<i>And the hearing of him immediately went out everywhere into the whole surrounding region of Galilee.</i>	<i>And so, throughout the whole region of Galilee, people kept talking about what Jesus had done.</i>

What happened with the news about Jesus?

The news about Jesus went out everywhere.

Mark 1:30

ULT	UST
<i>Now the mother-in-law of Simon was lying down, being sick with a fever, and immediately they speak to him concerning her.</i>	<i>Meanwhile, Simon’s mother-in-law was resting in bed because she had a fever. As soon as {Jesus arrived}, the people there told him that she was sick.</i>

When they went into Simon’s house, who did Jesus heal?

When they went into Simon’s house, Jesus healed Simon’s mother-in-law.

Mark 1:32-34

What happened when it was evening?

When it was evening, the people brought all who were sick or possessed by demons, and Jesus healed them.

Mark 1:35

ULT	UST
<i>And in the morning, {while it was} still very dark, having gotten up, he went out and went away to a desolate place, and there he was praying.</i>	<i>Jesus woke up early the next morning, before sunrise. He left {the house} and walked to a place where no one lived. He prayed {to God} there.</i>

What did Jesus do before the sun rose?

Before the sun rose, Jesus went out to a solitary place and prayed there.

Mark 1:38-39

What did Jesus tell Simon he had come to do?

Jesus said that he had come to preach in the surrounding towns.

Mark 1:40-41

What attitude did Jesus have toward the leper who begged Jesus to be healed?

Jesus had pity on the leper and healed him.

Mark 1:44

ULT	UST
<i>And he says to him, "See that you say nothing to anyone, but go, show yourself to the priest, and offer for your cleansing what Moses commanded, for a testimony to them."</i>	<i>"Do not tell anyone what just happened. Instead, go and show yourself to a priest {so that he can examine you and see that you no longer have the skin disease}. Also, present what Moses required you to offer to become ceremonially clean again. This will prove to the community {that you no longer have the skin disease}."</i>

What did Jesus tell the leper to do, and why?

Jesus told the leper to go offer the sacrifices according to what Moses commanded. It would serve the community as a testimony that he was healed.

Mark 2

Mark 2:4

ULT	UST
<i>And not being able to bring {him} to him because of the crowd, they removed the roof where he was, and having dug {it} out, they lower the mat where the paralytic was lying.</i>	<i>However, because of how many people were there, they could not carry the man close to Jesus. So, they went up on the flat roof of the house and dug a hole through it. Then, they lowered the man down as he was lying on his sleeping pad.</i>

What did the four men do who were carrying the paralyzed man?

The men removed the roof of the house and lowered the paralyzed man to Jesus.

Mark 2:5

ULT	UST
<i>And Jesus, having seen their faith, says to the paralytic, "Child, your sins are forgiven."</i>	<i>Jesus perceived that these people believed {that he could heal the man}. So, he said to the man who could not move, "Young man, I forgive you for your sins!"</i>

What did Jesus say to the paralyzed man?

Jesus said, "Child, your sins are forgiven."

Mark 2:6-7

Why did some of the scribes object to what Jesus had said?

Some of the scribes reasoned that Jesus had blasphemed because only God can forgive sins.

Mark 2:10-12

How did Jesus demonstrate that he had authority on earth to forgive sins?

Jesus told the paralyzed man to take up his bed and go to his house, and the man did.

Mark 2:13-14

What was Levi doing when Jesus told Levi to follow him?

Levi was sitting at the tax-collecting place when Jesus called him.

Mark 2:15-16

At Levi's house, what was Jesus doing that offended the Pharisees?

Jesus was dining with the sinful people and tax collectors.

Mark 2:17

ULT	UST
<i>And having heard, Jesus says to them, "The ones being healthy do not have need of a physician, but the ones having sickness. I did not come to call the righteous, but sinners."</i>	<i>Jesus learned what they said. He told them, "People who are well do not need a doctor. Rather, people who are sick need a doctor. I am here not to invite those who think they are righteous to come to me. Rather, {I invite} those who know that they have sinned {to come to me}."</i>

Who did Jesus say he had come to call?

Jesus said he had come to call sinful people.

Mark 2:18

ULT	UST
<i>And the disciples of John and the Pharisees were fasting, and they come and say to him, "For what reason do the disciples of John and the disciples of the Pharisees fast, but your disciples do not fast?"</i>	<i>One day, the Pharisees and the apprentices of John the Baptizer were abstaining from eating in order to please God. Meanwhile, some people visited Jesus. They asked him, "The apprentices of John the Baptizer and the apprentices of the Pharisees are abstaining from eating in order to please God. However, your apprentices do not do so. Why not?"</i>

What question did some people ask Jesus about fasting?

They asked Jesus why his disciples did not fast when John's disciples and the Pharisees' disciples did fast.

Mark 2:19

ULT	UST
<i>And Jesus said to them, "The sons of the bridal chamber are not able to fast while the bridegroom is still with them, are they? As much time as they have the bridegroom with them, they are not able to fast.</i>	<i>Jesus answered, "The friends of the bridegroom do not abstain from eating while the wedding celebration is still going on. Indeed, they continue to eat as long as the wedding celebration continues.</i>

How did Jesus explain why his disciples were not fasting?

Jesus said that while the bridegroom is still with the wedding attendants, they cannot fast.

Mark 2:23-24

What did Jesus' disciples do in some fields on the Sabbath which offended the Pharisees?

Jesus' disciples picked heads of grain and ate them on the Sabbath.

Mark 2:25-26

What example did Jesus give of someone who needed and ate bread normally forbidden for them?

Jesus gave the example of David who, out of need, ate the bread of the presence, normally reserved for the priests.

Mark 2:27

ULT	UST
<i>And he was saying to them, "The Sabbath was made for man, and not man for the Sabbath.</i>	<i>Then Jesus told the Pharisees, "God did not create humans because of the Jewish day of rest. Rather, he created the Jewish day of rest because of humans.</i>

For whom did Jesus say the Sabbath was made?

Jesus said the Sabbath was made for people.

Mark 2:28

ULT	UST
<i>Therefore, the Son of Man is Lord, even of the Sabbath."</i>	<i>So then, I, the Son of Man, can decide {what is right for people to do} even during the Jewish day of rest!"</i>

What authority did Jesus claim for himself?

Jesus said that he was Lord also of the Sabbath.

Mark 3

Mark 3:1-2

Why were they watching Jesus on the Sabbath in the synagogue?

They were watching Jesus to see if he would heal on the Sabbath, so they could accuse him.

Mark 3:4

ULT	UST
<i>And he says to them, "Is it lawful on the Sabbaths to do good or to do harm; to save a life or to kill?" But they were keeping silent.</i>	<i>Then Jesus told the Pharisees, "You know that the laws that God gave Moses allow people to do what is good and to rescue people on Jewish days of rest. They do not allow people to do what is wrong and to kill people {on Jewish days of rest}." However, the Pharisees did not respond to him.</i>

What question did Jesus ask the people about the Sabbath?

Jesus asked the people if it was lawful to do good, or to do harm on the Sabbath.

How did the people respond to Jesus' question?

The people were silent.

Mark 3:5

ULT	UST
<i>And having looked around at them with anger, being grieved by the hardness of their heart, he says to the man, "Stretch out your hand." And he stretched it out, and his hand was restored.</i>	<i>So Jesus stared at them angrily. Because they stubbornly refused to listen to him, he became very sad. Then Jesus commanded the man, "Extend the hand {that you cannot move}!" The man extended his hand, and he could move it again.</i>

What then was Jesus' attitude toward them?

Jesus became angry with them.

Mark 3:6

ULT	UST
<i>And having gone out, the Pharisees immediately were making counsel with the Herodians against him so that they might destroy him.</i>	<i>Then the Pharisees left {the Jewish meeting place}. As soon as {they left}, they met with some people who supported King Herod. Together, they started planning how they could kill Jesus.</i>

What did the Pharisees do when Jesus healed the man?

The Pharisees went out and plotted to put Jesus to death.

Mark 3:7-8

How many people followed Jesus as he went to the sea?

A great crowd followed Jesus.

Mark 3:11

ULT	UST
<i>And whenever the unclean spirits saw him, they were falling down before him and crying out, saying, "You are the Son of God."</i>	<i>Also, when demons saw Jesus, they caused the people whom they controlled to kneel down in front of Jesus and yell, "You are the Son of God!"</i>

What did the demons cry out when they saw Jesus?

The demons cried out that Jesus was the Son of God.

Mark 3:14-15

How many men did Jesus appoint as apostles, and what were they to do?

Jesus appointed 12 apostles who were to be with him, preach, and have authority to cast out demons.

Mark 3:19

ULT	UST
<i>and Judas Iscariot, who also handed him over.</i>	<i>Finally, he chose Judas Iscariot. He was the one who helped Jesus' enemies arrest him.</i>

Who was the apostle that would betray Jesus?

The apostle that would betray Jesus was Judas Iscariot.

Mark 3:21

ULT	UST
<i>And the ones from him, having heard, went out to seize him, for they were saying, "He is out of his mind."</i>	<i>Jesus' relatives heard about what was happening. They thought that Jesus was insane. So, they traveled {from the town of Nazareth to where Jesus was} to force him to return with them.</i>

What did Jesus' family think about the crowds and the events surrounding Jesus?

Jesus' family thought that he was out of his mind.

Mark 3:22

ULT	UST
<i>And the scribes having come down from Jerusalem were saying, "He has Beelzebul" and "By the ruler of the demons he casts out the demons."</i>	<i>Now some teachers of the Jewish law arrived from Jerusalem. They were telling people, "Beelzebul controls this man. In fact, it is the leader of the demons who enables him to force demons out of people!"</i>

What accusation did the scribes make against Jesus?

The scribes accused Jesus of driving out demons by the ruler of demons.

Mark 3:23-24

What was Jesus' response to the scribes' accusation?

Jesus responded that no kingdom divided against itself can stand.

Mark 3:28-29

What sin did Jesus say cannot be forgiven?

Jesus said that blasphemy against the Holy Spirit cannot be forgiven.

Mark 3:33-35

Who did Jesus say were his mother and brothers?

Jesus said that his mother and brothers were those who do the will of God.

Mark 4

Mark 4:1

ULT	UST
<i>And again, he began to teach beside the sea, and the largest crowd is gathered to him. As a result, having gotten into a boat, he sat down on the sea, and the whole crowd was on the land beside the sea.</i>	<i>Sometime later, Jesus again started to instruct people while he was next to the Sea of Galilee. A very large group of people assembled to hear him. Because {there were so many people}, he got into a boat on the sea and sat down {to teach}. All the people stood on the shore, by the water.</i>

Why did Jesus get into a boat to teach?

Jesus got into a boat to sit and teach because a very large crowd had gathered around him.

Mark 4:4

ULT	UST
<i>And it happened that as he sowed, some fell beside the road, and the birds came and devoured it.</i>	<i>As he was scattering them over the soil, some of the seeds fell on the path. Then some birds flew down and ate those seeds up.</i>

What happened to the seeds sown on the road?

The birds came and devoured them.

Mark 4:6

ULT	UST
<i>And when the sun rose, it was scorched, and because it had no root, it withered.</i>	<i>Then, the sun shone on the new plants and dried them up. Then, because they did not have good roots, the plants died.</i>

What happened to the seeds sown on the rocky ground when the sun rose?

They withered away because they had no root.

Mark 4:7

ULT	UST
<i>And other fell into the thorns, and the thorns grew up and choked it, and it did not give fruit.</i>	<i>Other seeds fell onto an area full of thorny plants. These thorny plants grew quickly and crowded out the grain plants. So, the grain plants did not produce a crop.</i>

What happened to the seeds sown among thorn plants?

The thorn plants choked them.

Mark 4:8

ULT	UST
<i>And others fell on the good soil, and it was giving fruit, growing up and being increased, and one was bearing 30, and one, 60, and one, 100."</i>	<i>Finally, other seeds fell on fertile soil. They grew quickly, and they produced a crop. Some plants produced 30 {grains of wheat each}, others produced 60 {grains each}, and others produced 100 {grains each}."</i>

What happened to the seeds sown in the good soil?

The seeds produced grain, yielding 30, 60, and some, 100 times what was planted.

Mark 4:11

ULT	UST
<i>And he was saying to them, "To you has been given the mystery of the kingdom of God, but to those, the ones outside, everything is in parables,</i>	<i>He replied, "God has revealed to you hidden things about his kingdom. However, I use only stories to instruct people who are not my apprentices.</i>

What did Jesus say was given to the Twelve, but not to those outside?

Jesus said the mystery of the kingdom of God was given to the Twelve, but not to those outside.

Mark 4:14

ULT	UST
<i>The sower sows the word.</i>	<i>{In the story that I told you,} the seeds that the farmer planted represent the good news.</i>

In Jesus' parable, what is the seed?

The seed is the word of God.

Mark 4:15

ULT	UST
<i>Now these are the ones beside the road, where the word is being sown, but whenever they have heard it, Satan immediately comes and takes away the word that was sown in them.</i>	<i>Some people are like the seeds that fell on the path. They hear the good news. However, as soon as they hear it, Satan comes and makes them forget the message that they heard.</i>

What does the seed sown on the road represent?

It represents those who hear the word, but immediately Satan takes it away.

Mark 4:16-17

What does the seed sown on the rocky ground represent?

It represents those who hear the word with joy, but when persecution comes, they stumble.

Mark 4:18-19

What does the seed sown among thorn plants represent?

It represents those who hear the word, but the cares of the world choke the word.

Mark 4:20

ULT	UST
<i>And those are the ones sown on the good soil, who hear the word and receive it and bear fruit—one, 30, and one, 60, and one, 100.”</i>	<i>Finally, other people are like the seeds that fell on fertile soil. When they hear the good news, they believe it. They are like the plants that produced a crop. Some plants produced 30 {grains of wheat each}, others produced 60 {grains each}, and others produced 100 {grains each}.”</i>

What does the seed sown in the good soil represent?

It represents those who hear the word, receive it, and produce fruit.

Mark 4:22

ULT	UST
<i>For it is not hidden except so that it might be revealed, nor has it become secret except so that it might come into visibility.</i>	<i>Here is what I mean: some things are secret, but that is only because God will {eventually} let everyone know about them.</i>

What did Jesus say would happen to the hidden and secret things?

Jesus said that the hidden and secret things would be brought into the light.

Mark 4:26-27

In what way is the kingdom of God like a man who casts his seed upon the ground?

The man casts the seed, and it grows, but he does not know how, then when the harvest is ripe he gathers it.

Mark 4:30-32

In what way is the kingdom of God like a mustard seed?

The mustard seed begins as the smallest of seeds, yet grows into a great plant where many can make their nests.

Mark 4:35-37

What happened as the disciples and Jesus crossed the lake?

A great storm began, threatening to fill the boat with water.

Mark 4:38

ULT	UST
<i>And he himself was in the stern, sleeping on the cushion. And they wake him up and say to him, "Teacher, is it not a concern to you that we are perishing?"</i>	<i>Meanwhile, Jesus was in the back part of the boat. He was asleep, with his head on a pillow. The apprentices woke him up and told him, "Instructor! We are going to die. You should be paying attention!"</i>

What was Jesus doing at this time in the boat?

Jesus was sleeping.

What question did the disciples ask Jesus?

The disciples asked Jesus if he cared that they were about to die.

Mark 4:39

ULT	UST
<i>And awaking, he rebuked the wind, and said to the sea, "Be silent! Be still!" And the wind ceased, and there was a great calm.</i>	<i>Then Jesus got up. He scolded the wind. He told the water, "Become still!" The wind stopped blowing, and everything became calm.</i>

What did Jesus then do?

Jesus rebuked the wind and calmed the sea.

Mark 4:41

ULT	UST
<i>And they feared a great fear and were saying to one another, "Who then is this, that even the wind and the sea obey him?"</i>	<i>The apprentices became very afraid. They kept asking each other, "Who could Jesus be? The wind and the water do what he says!"</i>

After Jesus did this, what was the response of the disciples?

The disciples were filled with great fear and wondered who Jesus was, that the wind and sea obeyed him.

Mark 5

Mark 5:1-2

Who met Jesus when they came to the region of the Gerasenes?

A man with an unclean spirit met Jesus.

Mark 5:4

ULT	UST
<i>because he had often been bound with shackles and chains, and the chains had been torn apart by him and the shackles had been shattered, and no one was strong enough to subdue him.</i>	<i>In the past, they had frequently tied him up with {metal} chains and bonds. However, he always snapped the {metal} chains and broke apart the bonds. He was so strong that nobody could overpower him.</i>

What had happened when people tried to restrain this man with chains?

When people tried to restrain this man with chains, he tore the chains apart.

Mark 5:7

ULT	UST
<i>And crying out with a loud voice, he says, "What to me and to you, Jesus, Son of the Most High God? I make you swear by God, do not torment me."</i>	

What title did the unclean spirit give Jesus?

The unclean spirit called Jesus the Son of the Most High God.

Mark 5:8

ULT	UST
<i>For he was saying to him, "Come out from the man, unclean spirit."</i>	

What did Jesus say to the unclean spirit in the man?

Jesus said, "Come out of the man, you unclean spirit."

Mark 5:9

ULT	UST
<i>And he was asking him, “What {is} your name?” And he says to him, “My name {is} Legion, for we are many.”</i>	<i>Then Jesus asked the man, “What do people call you?” He replied, “People call me ‘Thousands.’ {They call me that} because there are many of us demons in this man.”</i>

What was the name of the unclean spirit?

The unclean spirit’s name was Legion, because there were many.

Mark 5:13

ULT	UST
<i>And he permitted them, and having come out, the unclean spirits entered into the pigs, and the herd—about 2, 000—rushed down the steep slope into the sea and were drowned in the sea.</i>	<i>Jesus allowed them to do that. So, the demons left the man and began to control the pigs. Then, the herd of pigs rushed down the steep bank into the Sea of Galilee! There were about 2, 000 of them, and they drowned there in the sea.</i>

What happened when Jesus cast out the unclean spirit from the man?

The spirits came out and entered a herd of pigs, which ran down a steep hill and drowned in the lake.

Mark 5:15

ULT	UST
<i>And they come to Jesus and see the one being demon-possessed, sitting, clothed and being sound-minded—the one that had had the legion—and they were afraid.</i>	<i>When they arrived where Jesus was, they saw the man whom the thousands of demons had controlled. He was sitting down, he had clothes on, and he was thinking normally. So, {they realized how powerful Jesus must be, and} they became afraid.</i>

After the unclean spirit was cast out, what was the condition of the man?

The man was sitting with Jesus, clothed and in his right mind.

Mark 5:17

ULT	UST
<i>And they began to beg him to depart from their region.</i>	<i>Then the people who were there started to urge Jesus to leave their area.</i>

What did the people of the region ask Jesus to do?

The people asked Jesus to leave their region.

Mark 5:19

ULT	UST

Jesus said that in the resurrection, men and women will not marry, but will be like angels.

How did Jesus show from the scriptures that there is a resurrection?

Jesus quoted from the book of Moses, where God says that he is the God of Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob, all whom must then be still alive.

Mark 12:29-30

What commandment did Jesus say is most important?

Jesus said that to love the Lord your God with all your heart, soul, mind, and strength is the most important commandment.

Mark 12:31

<i>The second {is} this, 'You will love your neighbor as yourself.' There is no other commandment greater than these."</i>	<i>Here is the next most important law: 'You must care for people you know as much as you care for yourselves.' No other laws are more important than these two laws!"</i>

What commandment did Jesus say is second?

Jesus said that to love your neighbor as yourself is the second commandment.

Why did Jesus say that the poor widow had put in more than all who contributed to the offering box?

Jesus said she had contributed more because she gave out of her poverty while the others gave out of their abundance.

What was the name of the place where the soldiers brought Jesus to crucify him?

The name of the place was Golgotha, which means Place of a Skull.

<i>And having crucified him, also they divide his garments, casting a lot for them, who would take what.</i>	<i>After nailing Jesus to the cross, the soldiers split up his clothes by gambling for them. They did that to determine which piece of clothing each soldier would get.</i>

What did the soldiers do with Jesus' garments?

The soldiers cast lots for Jesus' garments.

<i>And this was the inscription of his charge, having been written: "The King of the Jews."</i>	<i>The soldiers wrote on a sign why {they were executing Jesus}. Here is what they wrote: "The king over the Jewish people."</i>

What charge against Jesus did the soldiers write on the sign?

The soldiers wrote "The King of the Jews" on the sign.

Mark 15:29-30

What did those who passed by challenge Jesus to do?

Those who passed by challenged Jesus to save himself and get down from the cross.

Mark 15:31-32

What did the chief priests say Jesus should do so they would believe?

The chief priests said that Jesus should come down from the cross so they would believe.

Mark 15:32

ULT	UST
<i>Let the Christ, the King of Israel, come down now from the cross so that we might see and might believe,” and the ones having been crucified with him were reviling him.</i>	<i>{He claims to be} the Messiah and the king over the people of Israel. So, he should get down now from that cross! That way, when we watch {him do that}, we will accept what he says.” The two men whom the soldiers had nailed to crosses near Jesus also insulted him.</i>

What titles did the chief priests use for Jesus as they mocked him?

The chief priests called Jesus the Christ and the King of Israel.

<i>And the sixth hour having come, darkness happened over the whole land until the ninth hour.</i>	<i>When it was noon, it became dark in that whole area. {It stayed dark} until three o’clock in the afternoon.</i>

What happened at the sixth hour?

At the sixth hour, darkness came over the whole land.

Mark 15:34

ULT	UST
<i>And at the ninth hour, Jesus cried out with a loud voice, “Eloi, Eloi, lema sabachthani?” which is translated, “My God, my God, why did you forsake me?”</i>	<i>At three o’clock in the afternoon, Jesus shouted, “Eloi, Eloi, lema sabachthani?” That means, “My God, my God, why did you abandon me?”</i>

What did Jesus cry out at the ninth hour?

Jesus cried out, “My God, my God, why have you forsaken me?”

Mark 15:37

ULT	UST
<i>And Jesus, having let out a loud voice, expired.</i>	<i>After that, Jesus shouted loudly. Then he stopped breathing and he died.</i>

What did Jesus do before he died?

Jesus cried out with a loud voice before he died.

Mark 15:38

ULT	UST
<i>And the curtain of the temple was split in two from top to bottom.</i>	<i>And then the drape hanging {in front of the Most Holy Place} in the temple ripped in half; it tore from the top to the bottom.</i>

What happened in the temple when Jesus died?

The curtain of the temple was split in two from top to bottom when Jesus died.

Mark 15:39

ULT	UST
<i>Now the centurion, having stood by opposite him, having seen that he expired in this way,said, "Truly this man was a Son of God."</i>	<i>There was a Roman officer standing there in front of Jesus. He observed how Jesus stopped breathing and died. He exclaimed, "This man really was God's Son!"</i>

What did the centurion testify when he saw how Jesus died?

The centurion testified that truly this man was the Son of God.

Mark 15:42

ULT	UST
<i>And evening already having come, because it was the Day of Preparation, that is, the day before the Sabbath,</i>	

On what day did Jesus die?

Jesus died on the day before the Sabbath.

Mark 15:43-46**What did Joseph of Arimathea do after Jesus died?**

Joseph of Arimathea took Jesus down from the cross, wrapped him in linen cloth, and laid him in a tomb, rolling a stone against the entrance of the tomb.

The women saw a young man dressed in a white robe sitting on the right side.

Behold, {this is} the place where they put him.</i>	<i>The young man told them, "Do not let what you see startle you! {I know that} you are looking for the body of Jesus from the town of Nazareth. He was the one whom soldiers killed by nailing him to a cross. God has made him alive again! He is no longer in this grave. Look at where people placed his body.</i>

What did the young man say about Jesus?

The young man said that Jesus was risen and was not there.

Mark 16:7

<i>But go, say to his disciples and to Peter, 'He is going before you to Galilee. There you will see him, just as he said to you.'</i>	<i>Now depart to his apprentices and tell them, especially Peter, that Jesus is going ahead of them to the region of Galilee. {Tell them that} Jesus will meet them there, which is what Jesus already told them."</i>

Where did the young man say the disciples would meet Jesus?

The young man said the disciples would meet Jesus in Galilee.

<i>[Now having arisen early in the morning on the first of the week, he appeared first to Mary Magdalene, from whom he had cast out seven demons.</i>	<i>[When Jesus lived again early on Sunday morning, Mary from the town of Magdala was the first person to see him. Jesus had forced seven demons out of her.</i>

To whom did Jesus first appear after his resurrection?

Jesus first appeared to Mary Magdalene.

Mark 16:11

ULT	UST
<i>And those {ones}, having heard that he lives and was seen by her, did not believe.</i>	<i>So, the apprentices learned that Jesus was alive and that Mary had seen him. However, they did not accept what she said.</i>

How did Jesus' disciples respond when Mary told them she had seen Jesus alive?

The disciples did not believe.

Mark 16:13

ULT	UST
<i>And those {ones}, having gone away, reported {it} to the rest, but they did not believe those {ones}.</i>	<i>Then, the two apprentices went back {to Jerusalem}. They told the other apprentices what had happened, but the others did not accept what the two apprentices said.</i>

How did Jesus' disciples respond when two other people told them they had seen Jesus alive?

The disciples did not believe.

Mark 16:14

ULT	UST
<i>Now later, he appeared to the Eleven, they reclining to eat, and he rebuked their unbelief and hardness of heart, because they did not believe the ones having seen him, having been raised from the dead.</i>	<i>Sometime later, Jesus revealed himself to his 11 representatives while they were eating. Because they had not accepted it when people told them that they had seen Jesus after God made him alive again, Jesus scolded them. He told them that they should not have stubbornly refused to accept what those people said.</i>

When he appeared to the disciples, what did Jesus say to them about their unbelief?

Jesus rebuked the disciples for their unbelief.

Mark 16:15

<i>And he said to them, "Having gone into all the world, preach the gospel to all the creation.</i>	<i>Then he told them, "Visit every place and proclaim the good news to every person!</i>

What command did Jesus give the disciples?

Jesus commanded the disciples to go into all the world and preach the gospel.

Mark 16:16

<i>The one having believed and having been baptized will be saved, but the one not having believed will be condemned.</i>	<i>God will rescue all people who trust in me and who have someone baptize them. However, God will punish all people who do not trust in me.</i>

Who did Jesus say would be saved?

Jesus said those who believed and were baptized would be saved.

Who did Jesus say would be condemned?

Jesus said those who did not believe would be condemned.

Mark 16:17-18

What signs did Jesus say would go with those who believed?

Jesus said those who believed would cast out demons, would speak in new languages, would not be hurt by anything deadly, and would heal others.

<i>After he spoke to them, the Lord Jesus was taken up into heaven and sat down at the right hand of God.</i>	<i>After the Lord Jesus said that to his apprentices, God brought him up into heaven. There, Jesus sat down to rule with God {the Father}.</i>

What happened to Jesus after he spoke to the disciples?

After he spoke to the disciples, Jesus was taken up into heaven and sat down at the right hand of God.

Mark 16:20

ULT	UST
<i>Now those {ones}, having gone out, preached everywhere, the Lord working with {them} and confirming the word through the accompanying signs. Amen.]</i>	<i>As for the apprentices, they left {Jerusalem} and proclaimed {the good news} in every place. The Lord {Jesus} helped them and enabled them to perform miracles. That way, people could see that the good news was true. May it be so!]</i>

What did the disciples then do?

The disciples then left and preached everywhere.

What did the Lord then do?

The Lord then worked with the disciples and confirmed the word with miraculous signs.
